## In 2026, We Are Building Champions

This fall marked one of our most successful Unified Sports Sem 1's in Alberta. Despite the challenges of the strike, schools across the province continued to engage through Unified soccer, basketball, and bocce events, while also welcoming our newest Special Olympics sport Floorball into the Unified space. Floorball proved to be a major success, with more than 400 athletes participating in events held in Edmonton, Red Deer, and Calgary. We also hosted the Unified Sports Conference, bringing together 75 educators and 30 students for the Youth Leadership Summit. Guided by the theme Building Champions, the conference reinforced a shared vision of Unified programming that extends beyond tournament teams to include in-school clubs, leadership opportunities, and inclusive school initiatives.
