Any firm or corporation which is actively involved in the installation, service or repair of any fire sprinkler system in Canada is eligible for Contractor/Voting Membership. Such firms or corporations must employ trades persons who hold a Provincial Sprinkler Fitter Certificate of Qualification card. In addition, members in this category must work to design drawings prepared by a P.Eng. proficient in fire protection, or a

N.I.C.E.T. Level III or Level IV Fire Protection Technician. A Contractor/Voting Member may do installations, ICI, Service and Residential work as well.

Membership Fees

The annual cost of a Contractor/Voting Membership is:

\$350.00 for third party review. \$308.00 for the head office annual fee \$100.00 for each branch office Plus 13% HST (#R100760123)

In order to remain a member in good standing, CASA requires:
