Board of Directors

Elected by and from CASA Members in good standing, usually representatives of local areas of the country, (one board member represents the AMS sector) purview over those affairs germane to the contracting and manufacturing interests of the industry, including, but not limited to labour relations, installation standards, building codes, legislations and other functions consistent with the Code of Ethics, Constitution, By-laws and Amendments of CASA.

Associate Manufacture Supplier (AMS) Category Definition

Any person, firm or corporation which manufactures, supplies, sells or distributes materials or devices whose end use is intended for fire protection systems is eligible for Associate Manufacturer/Supplier Membership, provided they are not eligible for any Voting Membership categories, which are installing contractor categories.

All applications for membership must be approved by the Board of Directors.

There are three Board Meetings each year, generally in March, June and November. The board has set a precedent to **reject any application which has not been completed in full.**

A cheque must accompany the application.
