ArtPrize Announces 2025 Pitch Night Series: \$10,000 in Grants for Artists

Grand Rapids, MI – ArtPrize, in partnership with leading arts organizations nationwide, is excited to announce the return of **Pitch Night**—a dynamic, live event where bold artistic visions come to life. Held in five cities across the U.S., this electrifying competition gives artists the chance to present their most ambitious ideas for a chance to receive a grant to help fund their participation in [ArtPrize 2025](#), taking place September 18 – October 4 in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Each Pitch Night will feature **five selected artists**, each given **five minutes** to present their idea to a **live audience and a panel of five judges**. After a brief Q&A, one winning artist per city will be awarded a **\$10,000 grant** to bring their concept to life at ArtPrize 2025—one of the world’s most dynamic cultural festivals, drawing nearly **800,000 visitors annually**.
