# **Keynote Speakers**



Qi Lu

### Founder and CEO of MiraclePlus

Qi Lu, founder and CEO of MiraclePlus (previously Y Combinator China), dedicated in investing and accelerating early-stage tech-driven startups. Qi received his PhD at Carnegie Mellon University. He also served as President and COO of Baidu and the Executive Vice President of Microsoft and Yahoo.

### **Topic - Seizing Opportunities in a New Era**

As we all know, OpenAl's technology breakthrough has ushed in a New Era where profound changes are unfolding at unprecedented paces.

How can we better understand what's coming?

How can we be better prepared ahead of the massive oncoming opportunities? In this talk, Qi Lu offers a particular perspective peeking into the future, through a combination of technology progression as well as innovation landscape emergence.

# Dean and Roy W. Carlson Professor of Engineering, College of Engineering, University of California, Berkeley - Berkeley, California

Tsu-Jae King Liu earned her B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees in electrical engineering from Stanford University and worked at the Xerox Palo Alto Research Center from 1992-1996. She joined the faculty at UC Berkeley in 1996, where she is now the Dean of the College of Engineering. Liu is a prolific author and inventor with over 550 publications and close to 100 patents. She is a fellow of IEEE and the National Academy of Inventors and an elected member of the U.S. National Academy of Engineering. Liu serves on the boards of Intel Corporation and MaxLinear, Inc. Her research contributions include the development of the FinFET transistor design. In addition to her research achievements, Liu is dedicated to enhancing the educational experience, supporting diversity, and inclusivity in engineering. She is leading efforts to renovate the Berkeley engineering student center and spearheading the American Semiconductor Academy (ASA) initiative to strengthen microelectronics education nationwide, earning her the IEEE Electron Devices Society Education Award.

### **Topic - Lighting the Way to a Brighter Future**

Advancements in information and communication technology (ICT) powered by semiconductor integrated circuits ("chips") have ushered in the Age of Artificial Intelligence, presenting new business opportunities as well as accelerating technology advancement itself. This talk will first provide a perspective on challenges and opportunities for continued ICT advancement, then describe elements of the entrepreneurship ecosystem at UC Berkeley that have contributed to its success as the top producer of alumni founders of venture-backed startups. Finally it will discuss keys to ensuring that technologies we develop and commercialize today will shape a brighter future for all.




Li Fan

### **Chief Technology Officer at Circle (Moderator)**

Li Fan is the CTO of Circle, a global financial technology firm that enables businesses to harness the power of digital currencies and public blockchains. She oversees all engineers and technical operations to deliver product development and business roadmaps. Before Circle, Li was the CTO of Lime, an innovative technology company that connect and empower urban living through mobility. Li was SVP and head of engineering in Pinterest from 2016 to 2018, a Senior Director of Engineering in Google Inc from 2014 to 2016. From 2012 to 2014, she was Vice President of engineering in Baidu, China, leading search product design and development Before that, she serves as executive director for the Baidu infrastructure and platform team (2010-2012).

Li developed her career in software development and engineering management in Cisco (1999-2000), Ingrian Networks (2000-2002), and Google (2002-2010). She holds a Master's Degree in Computer Science from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and a BS in Computer Science from Fudan University, Shanghai.

### **SVP of Engineering at Meta**

Bill Jia holds the role of SVP of Engineering at Meta, overseeing several critical areas including Al/ML Infrastructure, Data Infrastructure, Performance and Capacity Engineering, and Hardware Engineering. With a tenure that began in 2009, Bill has been at the forefront of shaping Meta's software product performance strategy, driving optimization and infrastructure planning for the company. He plays a pivotal role in defining Meta's hardware platform and strategy, contributing to the company's technological evolution. Furthermore, Bill's focus extends to the development of a cutting-edge Al/ML platform and infrastructure. These foundational components are instrumental in analyzing the world's largest dataset, and gaining insights to Meta's suite of products, such as Search, Ads, News Feed, Photos, Videos, and more, all aimed at enhancing the user experience. At Meta's Al Infra, one of the most widely used Al frameworks, PyTorch, was nurtured and expanded by Bill and his dedicated team.

Prior to Meta, Bill spent around 4 years at Microsoft and was in charge of improving and optimizing various Microsoft online services. He received dual BS degrees from Shanghai Jiao Tong University and received his MS degree from National University of Singapore. Bill obtained his PhD degree in operations research and algorithms design from the University of Southern California (USC) in 2007.

### **Topic - Building a Strong Leadership in an Ever-Changing Environment**

Leadership is by its nature the most contextual and pivotal spirit of any team or org. This is especially true in the high tech industry, when tech innovation is accelerating, Al is reshaping the global landscape, geo-political tension is on the rise and the economy teeters on the brink of recession. On this fireside chat, we welcome Bill Jia, a SVP of Eng and Al from Meta, to talk about the intricate nuances of leadership in this ever-changing landscape, shedding light on the novel challenges and exciting opportunities that await those in leadership roles. Weijie Yun

### Founder and Managing Partner of Tyche Partners (Moderator)

Weijie Yun is the Founder and Managing Partner of Tyche Partners. As a serial entrepreneur, Weijie brings deep industry domain knowledge to identify investment opportunities and hands-on operating experience to help portfolio companies to grow their business.

Weijie's passion is to identify and invest in visionary entrepreneurs with breakthrough technologies in the hard tech space, such as IT infrastructure (big data, storage and networking), IoT and wearable devices, 3D printing, autonomous driving, consumer electronics, and semiconductor. Currently, he is serving as a board member/observer at Crossbar, Formlabs, Latticework, mCube, Motiv, Pavilion, and Qumulo. His other investments include Aeye, Basebit, Desktop Metal, Ripcord, Shoof, and SpinLaunch.

Before founding Tyche Partners, Weijie was an entrepreneur with proven track record of combining his technical insights and market intuition to maximize companies' value. He was the founder and CEO of Telegent Systems, AIP Networks and SiTek. Currently, he is a member of the Board of Trustees at UC Berkeley Foundation, and a founding board member of M.E.T. program at UC Berkeley. He received his M.S. and Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering and Computer Sciences from UC Berkeley.



**Jun Wu** 

### Renowned Investor and Expert in AI, NLP and Web Search

Dr. Jun Wu, Founding Partner of Amino Capital, Adjunct Professor at Shanghai Jiaotong University, Former Senior Staff Research Scientist at Google, Former VP at Tencent Technologies, and board member of five public and private companies.

A renowned expert in artificial intelligence, natural language processing, and web search, Dr. Jun Wu began his career at Google as a software engineer, and subsequently as a research scientist, in 2002. Shortly after he joined, Dr. Wu received the Google Engineering Award for his accomplishments in web search anti-spam. He was the original author of Google's Chinese/Japanese/Korean search algorithms; the inventor of many Google technologies using natural language processing; and was highly appraised by Eric Schmidt and Sergey Brin for his contributions to the company. He co-founded the engineering departments of APAC, which evolved into the Google offices in China, Japan, and Korea. Dr. Wu joined Tencent Technologies as the VP in charge of Search, Infrastructure, Maps, and Search Ads from 2010 - 2012. In only two years, he helped boost the company's search traffic and revenue by 6-fold. Dr. Wu re-joined Google in 2012 and initiated efforts in smart search and automatic question/answering. In 2014, he left Google to co-found Amino Capital, where he invested in about 300 startup companies, including Zoom, Grail, Meituan, Kuaishou, Weee, and Dfinity.

Dr. Wu is a member of the Advisory Board of the Whiting School of Engineering at Johns Hopkins, and he has given back to the school in many ways since his graduation. He has authored many award-winning books, inspiring millions of young people to participate in the IT industry. He has also published tens of papers in journals and conferences and was granted about twenty patents in the US and internationally.Dr. Wu obtained his Master's and Ph.D. degrees in Computer Science from Johns Hopkins University, and his Bachelor's degree from Tsinghua University.

# VP of Client Computing Group, General Manager of Segment Marketing at Intel


