The City of Toronto has begun work on a transformational project located at 805 Wellington Street West. This project will revitalize the former “Strachan House” building and surrounding lands into a new mixed-income community. This site is one of many publicly owned properties the City is investing in to support the approval of 285,000 new homes in the next 10 years, as part of the City’s HousingTO Action Plan.

The Community Meeting will be hosted by the City with CreateTO, the agency responsible for managing the City’s real estate assets, in addition to staff from Development Review, City Planning and the Housing Development Office.
