The EF Ultimate Break Code of Conduct outlines our expectations for you as a Campus Ambassador and traveler. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in your removal from the Campus Ambassador program. Please report any behavior that doesn't align with these guidelines.

EF Community Guidelines

Our expectations:

- Treat everyone with fairness and respect
- Be open-minded, listen to different ideas and perspectives
- Recognize personal blind spots to understand each other's differences
- Act in a respectful, kind, and approachable manner to all travelers on tour, and on campus
- Comply with all local laws and regulations in the places you visit
- Respect any rules your Tour Director or local guides outline on tour
- Practice the "carry in, carry out" policy—no littering, defacing, or harvesting of natural resources
- Do not touch/approach wildlife unless permitted by your local guide
- Remain open to the cultural exchanges your guide or other community members share with you
- Hold yourself to high standards of personal and professional conduct.

These are the standards we hold all travelers to—Campus Ambassadors included. As a part of this community, you're a representative of our company and ethos.

Compliance:

Follow your university's policies as well as state and federal laws (including privacy regulations like FERPA). Each school has its own code of conduct. You can usually find it on the student life section of your university's website or by contacting student affairs or your program coordinator directly.

Time Management: Balance your academic commitments with ambassador duties. Be punctual, reliable, and manage your time effectively.

Conduct Expectations:

Alcohol & Drugs: Do not consume alcohol or use drugs before or during your ambassador responsibilities.

Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in removal from the Campus Ambassador program and could lead to additional disciplinary action from your university.
