Question and Responses:

Question 1: Why is the current mural at the VA Ave bridge underpass being painted over when it was just repainted in 2024?

Response 1: The most recent mural at the Virginia Avenue Bridge was commissioned by the Beltline in 2020 and installed in 2021 by Alex Brewer (HENSE). While there have been efforts to maintain and retouch areas of the original mural in recent years, this call is an opportunity for an artist to create new artwork at this site.

Question 2: How flexible is the installation timeline of April/May 2026?

Response 2: The installation timeline is flexible; however the intent of this project is for an artist to develop a final design immediately after the contracting phase has concluded and coordinate the installation of this design with installation completed by May.

Question 3: Is there currently an anti-graffiti coating on the mural?

Response 3: There has been no recent application of anti-graffiti coating on the existing mural.

Question 4: Is an anti-graffiti or clear UV coating required to be put on the mural by the artist?

Response 4: It is strongly recommended that a non-sacrificial anti-graffiti coating be applied to the work and be reflected in the artists' overall project plan and project budget.

Question 5: Will the wall be cleaned and pressure-washed by ABI prior to artist installation?

Response 5: All wall-prep is the responsibility of the commissioned artist team. The Atlanta Beltline will provide assistance to coordinate and support these activities.

Question 6: Will the Beltline path be closed during installation, or is the artist required to work on a partially open and populated path?

Response 6: The Atlanta Beltline Art team will work closely to coordinate all necessary trail closures and detours to ensure the safety of the artist team and Trail users. The extent of Trail closures and detours will be determined by the Atlanta Beltline's Asset Management Team.

Question 7: Should the newly commissioned mural be vandalized or tagged following completion, will the awarded artist be held responsible for maintenance?

Response 7: Any tagging will be addressed by Atlanta Beltline Art staff and team of conservators. In the event of reported vandalism, the awarded artist will be notified immediately.
