5:10 - Historic & Cultural Resources Study Update / The recent opinion piece by Cox Enterprises' Chairman & CEO recommending shifting away from Beltline rail, we need to understand how this is going to affect ABI planning to ABI / Joe Iacobucci in the transit questions to be sent in advance of the June full committee meeting.
