

Southside Trail — Segments 2-3 Construction Update







- Approx. 1.8 miles
- Pittsburgh Yards® just west of I-75/85 overpass to Boulevard SE
- 14' wide trail, landscape, fiber duct bank, retaining walls, bridge maintenance & upgrades, lighting, security cameras
- New access points at Pryor Road, McDonough Blvd, DH Stanton Park, Hill Street, Grant Street & Grant Terrace
- Est. completion: Q2 of 2026































Southside Trail — Segments 4-5 Construction Update








- Approx. 1.1 miles
- Boulevard to Glenwood Avenue
- 14' wide trail, landscape, fiber duct bank, retaining walls, bridges, ADA access ramps, lighting, security cameras
- Construction start date: June 2023
- Trail Soft Opening: December 2025
- Final Est. completion: February 2026
- Contractor: Reeves Young, LLC






Southside Trail – Segment 6 Design



- **Design Team:** Heath & Lineback
- Status: Preliminary Design
- Design Funding: 100% Local (Beltline)
- Design Complete: Summer 2026
- Construction Funding: \$5M federal (pending TIP adoption in March 2025)

- Glenwood Avenue to Memorial Drive, along Bill Kennedy Way
- Draft 75% Plans
