




Alignment Options Overview








Southwest and Southeast Quadrants






Southwest & Southeast Quadrants






Southwest Alignment and Stations





Southeast Alignment and Stations






Service Planning





Service Plan

- 3 Routes with bi-directional service
 - Beltlineloop(blue)
 - Northernloop (red)
 - Southernloop (yellow)
- 20-minuteheadways
 - Average 10-minute headways at each station
- 1-Seat ride anywhere in system
- Includes MARTA HRT Infill stations







Alignment	# of Stations	% In Street	Eastbound Travel Times	Westbound Travel Times	Adjusted Average Speed (mph)
CSX	8	28%	20:15	20:45	16.6
Peachtree	10	45%	25:45	26:30	13.7
Ottley	9	66%	26:15	26:45	12.4

^{*}CSX Alignment saves 5-6 minutes each direction




Overall Cost Summary
