Entry Registration

All exhibitors must be registered as attendees of the Farmfair International 4-H Alberta Day event on November 7, 2026. **Members must register for 4-H Alberta Day by the deadline of October 23, 2026.** Members are encouraged to also register in advance for the Bench Show, but additional entries will be received during registration for 4-H Alberta Day, provided there is enough space.

Entries must remain on display until the end of 4-H Alberta Day activities (approximately 3:30 pm). Members may then collect their entries and any ribbons.

Help Us Reduce Food Waste

In an effort to reduce food waste, Farmfair International will be providing disposal bins onsite during move out. Exhibitors can choose to deposit their food entries in these bins to be composted.

Ribbons & Results

The Farmfair International 4-H Alberta Day Bench Show shall use the Fair System of Judging. Only one 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place ribbon shall be awarded in each class.

First Place Red Ribbon
Second Place Blue Ribbon
Third Place White Ribbon

General Rules

Please read directions carefully for class (regarding dimensions, size, quantity of items required, etc). Failure to follow directions may result in the item being disqualified.

All exhibitors **MUST** be the bona fide maker of their exhibits. The use of commercially produced products is prohibited.

Only Judges and designated exhibition officials are allowed in the Exhibit Area during Judging. Judges will be selected from a pool of qualified individuals as determined by event organizers.

All entries must arrive during the move in time noted. Organizers reserve the right to refuse entries that arrive after the designated time. Entries must be removed during the designated move out time. Entries not picked up during this time become the property of Farmfair International.

Entries will be divided into exhibitors respective age division as determined by 4-H Alberta: Cleaver Kids (6-8 years old), Junior (9-11 years old), Intermediate (12-14 years old), and Senior (15-20 years old). All ages are December 31, 2026.

All entries must have official exhibition tags attached. Tags will be available during entry drop off.

Exhibitors may submit a maximum of one (1) entry per class. Exhibits are to be entered under only one name.

Entries containing scenes of violence, nudity, or sexually suggestive content will not be accepted.

Organizers reserve the right to combine classes due to insufficient entries or divide classes with extensive entries into multiple classes. Organizers may also move an entry if it better fits in another class.

Interpretation of all rules shall be made by exhibition officials, whose decision shall be final. Should any question arise not provided for in the Rules and Regulations, the decision of the exhibition officials shall be final. The right to alter, interpret, amend, add to or cancel any of these rules, or to grant relaxation from them in individual cases is reserved to the exhibition officials.

All properties of exhibitors entered for competition shall be subject to control of the organizers, but in no case shall Farmfair International be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury of any nature to any such property while in its possession. Organizers will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of articles, but property owners should make their own arrangements for coverage against loss, damage or injury.



ART

Junior/Intermediate/Senior Art

1. Photography- color or black and white, 4" x 6" or 5 x 7", unframed, mounted on sturdy backing of neutral color with a border
2. Painting or Drawing- unframed. Use of pencil, crayon, or paint.
3. Sewing- any one item or set.
4. Papercraft- one scrapbooking page or a set of 3 or 4 greeting cards with envelopes.
5. Lego or Model- use of Lego or model kit. Displays to not exceed 18" x 24".

Cleaver Kids Art

1. Photography- color or black and white, 4" x 6" or 5 x 7", unframed, mounted on sturdy backing of neutral color with a border
2. Painting or Drawing- unframed. Use of pencil, crayon, or paint.
3. Lego or Model- use of Lego or model kit. Displays to not exceed 18" x 24".

BAKING

All entries must be prepared by the exhibitor with original ingredients. No commercial mixes can be used. Entries must not need to be refrigerated (no custard or meat products). Entries should be displayed on a white plate (can be paper) in a clear plastic bag (ziploc or twist tie) with entry tags attached to the plastic bag. Include the variety (ie. Chocolate Chip Cookies, Carrot Muffins, etc).

Junior/Intermediate/Senior Baking

1. Cookies, 3
2. Muffins, 3
3. Unbaked or Baked Squares (Rice Krispies Squares, Brownies, etc), 3

Cleaver Kids Baking

1. Cookies, Muffins, or Squares, 3
