ENTRY DEADLINE

Online Entries - October 15, 2025

NO entries or substitutions will be accepted after Oct. 15th at midnight.

ENTRY FEES

Confirmation Class \$50.00/entry (by entering conformation, you are automatically entered in showmanship)

Showmanship \$25.00/entry (ONLY for those who do not have an animal in a conformation class)

Cattle Panels* \$175.00 (2.5 animals per 10ft panel recommended)

1/2 Cattle Panel \$87.50

Tie out Fee** \$20.00 (Includes bedding for the week)

GST is no longer included in all entry fees. GST will be added at checkout. Fees are payable to Farmfair International which must accompany entries. All entries MUST be made through Farmfair International.

**Each animal requires a tie out space, if an animal is in more than one show, only purchase one tie out space per animal.

AGE CATEGORIES

Age as of November 1, 2025

A. Pee Wee 8 & under
B. Junior 9 - 11 years
C. Intermediate 12 - 14 years
D. Senior 15 - 21 years

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair.
- 2. Parent participation is not allowed apart from exhibitor and/or public safety. Adults will not be allowed to assist with the preparation of animals. Juniors are encouraged to assist other juniors. Exhibitors in violation of this rule will be disqualified from the show.
- 3. The show committee and management reserve the right to make decisions on any point not covered by these rules and to make corrections as necessary.
- 4. Show number will be mandatory in the show ring.

Conformation Show

- 1. Animals must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or farm corporations that the junior is a member of, however animals must be exhibited by the junior named on the entry form.
- 2. Animals registered jointly by two juniors may only be exhibited by one junior.
- 3. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Animals may be entered in a maximum of one class. No cross entries between divisions.
- 4. Calendar year calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in their respective class. If both would qualify to advance only one animal unit can advance.
- 5. Division Champions from the Purebred Show only, will qualify for the Purebred Grand Champion Female award and which is eligible for the Alberta Supreme Show. Commercial champions are not eligible
- 6. An animal may be asked to leave the show ring at the discretion of the Junior Show committee and Farmfair management.
- 7. All grooming must be done by JUNIORS ONLY. Juniors may assist one another.
- 8. Classes will be split by age of animal if warranted after entries close at the discretion of the committee and Farmfair management.
- 9. The commercial and purebred shows are open to exhibitors 21 years of age (as of Nov 1, 2025) and under. There is no minimum age, however, if a young person requires help, it is highly recommended someone 21 years and under assists.

Commercial Show

Animals entered in the Commercial Division do not need to be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family, or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Animals may be of any percentage.

- 1. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2025
- 2. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
- 3. Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st December 31st, 2024

- 4. Champion & Reserve Champion Junior Female
- 5. Two-Year-Old Heifer: Born in 2023, with her own 2025, natural calf at foot
- 6. Mature Cow: Born in 2022 or prior with her own 2025, natural calf at foot
- 7. Champions & Reserve Champion Commercial Division

Purebred Show

Animals entered in the Purebred Division do not need to be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family, or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Papers designating purebred status are required as per breed association rules.

- 8. Purebred Junior Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born on or after March 1, 2025
- 9. Purebred Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Heifer Calf
- 10. Purebred Senior Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born January 1 February 28, 2025
- 11. Purebred Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Heifer Calf
- 12. Purebred Junior Yearling Heifer: Born from March 1st- December 31st, 2024
- 13. Purebred Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Female
- 14. Purebred Senior Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st- February 28th, 2024
- 15. Purebred Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Female
- 16. Purebred Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2025
- 17. Purebred Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
- 18. Two-Year Old Cow with Calf: Born in 2023 with her own 2025 natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
- 19. Champion & Reserve Champion Two-Year Old Female
- 20. Mature Cow: Born in 2022 or prior with her own 2025, natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
- 21. Champion & Reserve Champion Mature Female
- 22. Purebred Junior Futurity Champion & Reserve Grand Champion

(Champions from classes 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19 & 21 advance to the Champion Class)

Purebred Junior Futurity Grand Champion is eligible for the Alberta Supreme Show

Pee Wee Showmanship (Following Confirmation prior to Showmanship Finals)

Anyone 8 and under as of Nov 1, 2025, is eligible for Pee Wee Showmanship. If an exhibitor does not have an animal to show, they may ask to borrow an animal from another farm or junior in the barn.

Showmanship Finals (Immediately following Peewee Showmanship)

Throughout the confirmation show (Commercial and Purebred), showman will be judged and advanced to the final showmanship classes. Those who advance will be announced following each class.

- 1. Exhibitors must enter and pay a showmanship fee at time of entry.
- 2. To be entered in showmanship, the junior MUST be entered in the confirmation portion of the Junior Futurity.

Junior Supreme Show (Immediately following Showmanship Finals)

Champions from previous shows will be invited to compete in the Junior Supreme Show. The champion will be eligible to show in the Alberta Supreme Show Saturday afternoon.

AWARDS
