***Exhibitors will buy indoor hall space by the panel. This space will be used to stall show and/or display cattle.**

**** Exhibitors must purchase one tie out per animal.**

GST is no longer included in all entry fees. GST will be added at checkout. Fees are payable to Farmfair International which must accompany entries. All entries MUST be made through Farmfair International.

INTERNATIONAL AGBUSINESS CENTRE MEMBERSHIP

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes.
3. Eligible Cattle: a. Beef Shorthorn, Lincoln Red and Dual-Purpose Shorthorn – all purebred males and females. b. Graded-up Shorthorns of registered status (7/8 females or 87.5% and 15/16 males or 93.8%) are shown as purebred. All calves shown at foot of their Dam must be registered and purebred. c. Shorthorn Plus of registered status (4/8 females 50% to 7/8 or 87.4% and 8/16 males 50% to 15/16 or 93.7%).
4. All animals entered in the Shorthorn Plus classes must be registered as “Shorthorn Plus”. Shorthorn Plus cattle are only eligible to participate in the Shorthorn Plus Division and must be accompanied by proof of registration. This applies to all classes, including overall champion, group classes, premier breeder, and premier exhibitor (if offered). Under no circumstances may Shorthorn Plus cattle be shown in purebred Shorthorn classes at a purebred show. Points awarded in the Shorthorn Plus show are not eligible to count toward overall purebred achievements.
5. Any Shorthorns shown at Farmfair are subject to parentage tests and/or mouthing. Tests to be supervised by the Executive Committee of the Alberta Shorthorn Association. In the event that the veterinarian determines the animal’s age is incorrect, that animal will be barred from showing.
6. Shorthorn cattle born in Canada and shown by a Canadian exhibitor must carry Canadian registration papers issued by the Canadian Shorthorn Association. All foreign registration papers will be evaluated according to the Canadian Shorthorn Association’s Rules of Eligibility for Registration in Canada.
7. Original registration papers must be available on all cattle.
8. If numbers of entries warrant, classes may be split.
9. Exhibitors must be Shorthorn members in good standing i.e. paid Canadian members; out of country exhibitors are exempt.
10. Only purebred champions will qualify to compete in the Alberta Supreme Show
11. The classes will pay \$1000.00 (\$700 for first, \$300 for second) in the following classes 2, 4, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17-19, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28, 30-31.)
12. Show numbers will be mandatory to be worn by all exhibitors in the show ring.
