RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
- 2. Classes will have a maximum of 10 head per class.
- 3. The maximum age spread of four months or 122 days for junior cattle and calves will apply.
- 4. Classes will be finalized after all entries are checked in by the show committee.
- 5. Limousin cattle in the purebred classes must be 90% purebred or more.
- 6. Percentage Classes- Limousin cattle in the percentage class must be registered with the Canadian Limousin Association as either a Percentage or Lim-Flex® animal, as per the below guidelines. Percentage
- Limousin cattle that contain 37.5% to 89% Limousin blood as calculated by the association. Lim-Flex® -Percentage Limousin cattle that contain between 37.5% to 75% of Limousin blood and 25% to 62.5% from a registered Red or Black Angus.
- 7. Heifer calves shown at foot are not eligible to be shown in the individual heifer calf classes. Bull calves may be shown individually.
- 8. Breeders Herd can be comprised of Purebred and/or Percentage cattle.
- 9. Only purebred champions will qualify to compete in the Alberta Supreme Show.
- 10. Purebred & Percentage animals will qualify towards Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor.
- 11. All Division Champions will be paid out as follows: \$635.00 Champion; \$275.00 Reserve Champion (Classes 2, 4, 6, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 22, 24, 26, 28, 29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 40). Further prizing will be included with the work of the Alberta Limousin Association. Please watch social media for updates as we get closer to the show.
- 12. Show numbers will be mandatory to be worn by all exhibitors in the show ring.
