EXPERIENCE LEVEL FOR SESSIONS

Building Proficiency - Audience: Regular users with moderate to high confidence.

All Levels - Audience: Everyone—from first-time users to seasoned experts.

Open to all attendees regardless of experience. These sessions are structured to provide value across the spectrum, often featuring collaborative discussions, demonstrations, or flexible content that adapts to the audience's needs.
