REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Request for Proposals for Purchase of Waste Containers

RFP ISSUED: February 9, 2026

PROPOSALS DUE: February 13, 2026

A. REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Fifth Avenue Association (“FAA”) is seeking proposals for the purchase, delivery, and optional installation of roadway waste containers compliant with applicable laws and regulations, including NYC Department of Sanitation (DSNY) Clean Curbs Program and applicable NYC Department of Transportation (DOT) requirements. Purchased containers should be suitable for installation in the roadway/curb lane of New York City streets.

Currently, FAA removes between 100 to 350 bags of garbage per day from our district.

FAA seeks to purchase a number of containers sufficient to hold up to 350 bags of garbage with an accent vinyl wrap (covering less than 25% of containers exterior surface area) as well as appropriate roadway protections (e.g. wheel stops and delineators) to protect the containers from contact by vehicles in the roadway.

FAA seeks to purchase 8 to 12 containers that meet FAA’s requirements and comply with applicable laws and regulations, including the requirements of DSNY’s Clean Curb Program. This quantity is provided for pricing purposes only and does not represent a guaranteed minimum purchase. Final quantities are subject to site approvals, operational needs, and regulatory requirements.

FAA may purchase containers in phases and reserves the right to award all, part, or none of the quantities requested. FAA anticipates placing an order for all required containers by March 31st, 2026, and the selected vendor must commit to the delivery of Purchased Items on or before June 30, 2026

Vendors must confirm that proposed containers meet all applicable NYC DSNY and NYC DOT rules and regulations, including the requirements of the Clean Curbs Program.

B. BACKGROUND

The Fifth Avenue Association is a New York not-for-profit organization that provides services in the Fifth Avenue Business Improvement District and is recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a charitable, tax-exempt organization pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Fifth Avenue Association works to ensure Fifth Avenue is the most iconic street in the world. Since 1907, it has been instrumental in making Fifth Avenue a dynamic space of beauty and luxury where all are welcome to discover the best that commerce and culture have to offer.

C. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Proposals may consist of a formal quote with supporting materials and must include:

- Manufacturer and model
- Cut sheet or product link
- Confirmation of Clean Curbs compliance
- Dimensions and capacity
- Materials and finish options
- Unit pricing, including delivery and installation within FAA's district boundaries
- Description of proposed roadway protection measures, with pricing
- Optional installation/anchoring cost (if offered)
- Lead time
- Applicable terms and conditions, including warranty information

D. PRICES AND TAXES; INVOICING

The prices agreed upon by the Proposer and FAA shall not be subject to change unless agreed to by the Proposer and FAA in writing.

The price shall include all applicable sales, franchise, income, or other taxes with regard to the purchase of goods, which shall be paid by the Proposer.

E. ADDITIONAL PROPOSAL INFORMATION

PASSPort (VENDEX): City of New York's PASSPort approval is required to submit a proposal. Contractors who need to update their PASSPort approval or are not yet PASSPort approved are strongly encouraged to begin the process as soon as practicable. F. EVALUATION

FAA reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and is not required to select the lowest-priced proposal.
