YOUTH SPORTS BETTING

LITTLE LEAGUE INTERNATIONAL CONDEMNS BETTING ON YOUTH COMPETITION

Little League Baseball publicly denounced gambling on its World Series games involving 10- to 12-year-olds.

OFFSHORE GAMBLING ON THE LITTLE LEAGUE WORLD SERIES FEELS 'DIRTY,' TEAMS SAY

Some MLB-style youth teams and organizers have expressed moral concerns about offshore sportsbooks offering odds on youth games

CINCINNATI COUNCILMAN SAID BETTING ON HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS IS REASON FOR VIOLENCE UPTICK

YOUTH SPORTS BETTING SAFETY COALITION DEBUTS IN MASSACHUSETTS

Massachusetts launched a coalition (AG's office + sports teams) to create education and prevention programs about gambling risks for 12- to 20-year-olds.

DEFINITION

GAMBLING:

**RISKING SOMETHING OF VALUE, IN HOPES OF GAINING
SOMETHING OF GREATER VALUE, BUT THERE IS A CHANCE OF
LOSING WHAT THEY HAVE**

**GAMBLING ADDICTION IS NOW CONSIDERED AS A
BEHAVIORAL ADDICTION**

**Recent estimates say that
US gambling revenue
annually drives \$116 billion
combining commercial and
tribal gaming operations.**

**85% OF US ADULTS HAVE
GAMBLED, MOST OF
WHICH DON'T EXPERIENCE
ANY PROBLEMS WITH
GAMBLING**

**ESTIMATED 2%-3% OF US ADULTS EXPERIENCE PROBLEMS WITH
GAMBLING**

THAT EQUATES TO 4-6 MILLION PEOPLE

**ABOUT 2 MILLION PEOPLE CAN BE CLASSIFIED AS HAVING A
GAMBLING DISORDER. THIS RATE IS HIGHER AMONGST YOUTH**

Recovery Matters

Suicide rates are 12X higher than any other addiction

80% of gambling addicts fall off the wagon.

What is problem gambling?

When gambling begins to harm someone's mental or physical health, relationships or finances, and/or interferes with work, school, or extracurricular activities

RISKS FOR PROBLEM GAMBLING

MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES

Substance use, personality disorders, depression, anxiety often accompany problem gambling

AGE 10-24 YEARS

Youth have higher rates of problem gambling than adults

GENDER

Men typically engage in problem gambling more than women

Behavioral Health Issue

Dopamine is a neurotransmitter that makes people feel excited



DOPEMINE HIT TO BRAIN WHETHER YOU WIN OR LOSE

SIGNS OF GAMBLING ADDICTION

**Easy to miss the signs because the physical effects are not seen
(unlike substance or alcohol dependency)**



SIGNS OF GAMBLING ADDICTION

Needs to gamble with increasing amounts of money

Restless or irritable attempting to stop gambling

Unsuccessful efforts to stop

Gambles when feeling distressed

After losing money, often returns another day to get even

(Gambling is solution to the problem, not the cause)

3 C'S

Significant Mental Health Problems ie. depression & anxiety

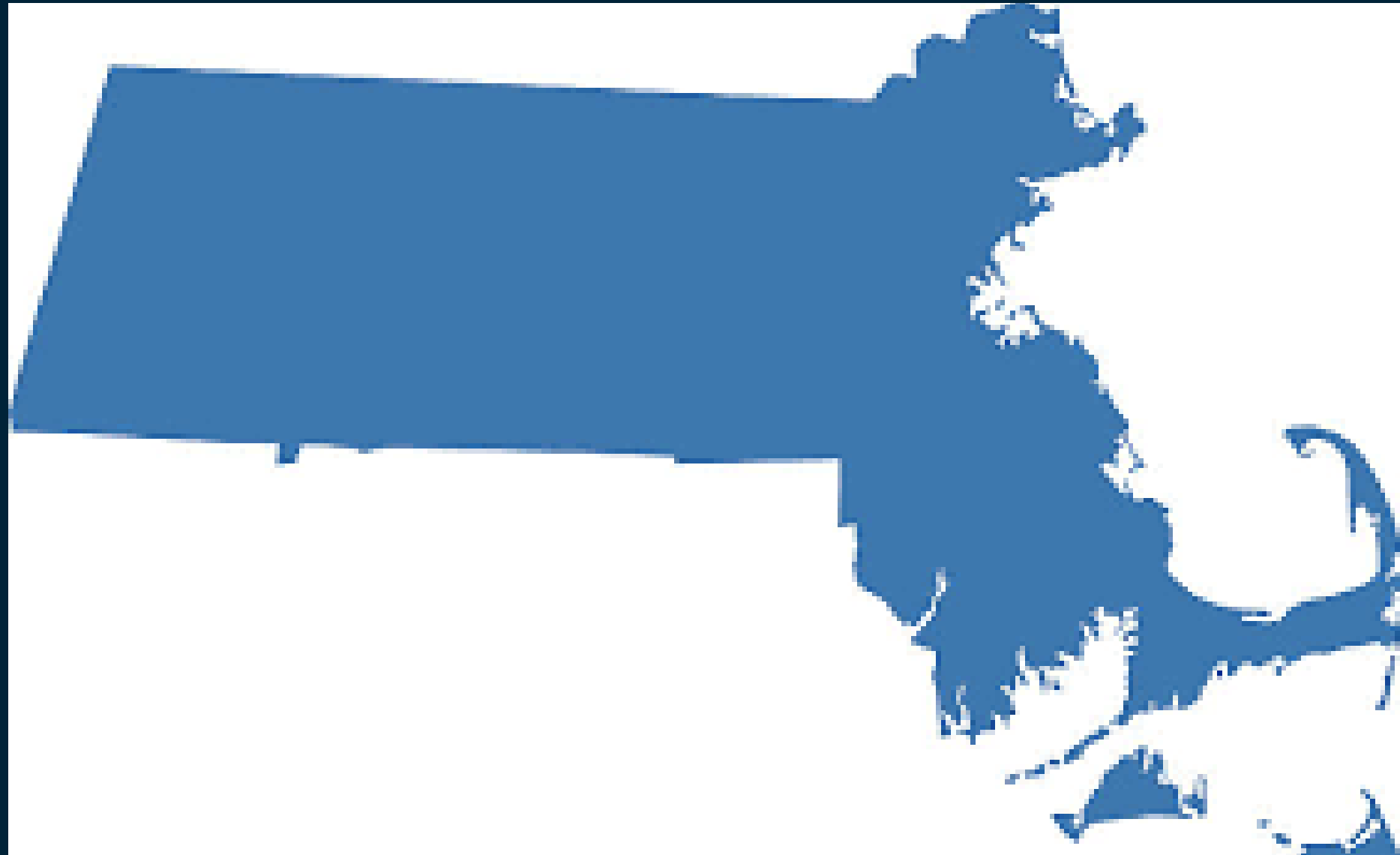
