Rules Revisions

1. Stick checks may be requested during the following stoppages:
 - Quarter breaks
 - Halftime
 - A team time-out
 - Prior to the start of an over-time period
 - Prior to the start of a draw
 - Immediately following goals in regulation and overtime periods
2. Electronic communication devices (audio and video) worn by on-field players are prohibited during games. Coach misconduct penalties will apply when violated.
3. When a possession time-out is called and the goalkeeper has possession of the ball in the goal circle, play will resume at the closest dot, and any player may re-start play unless play is to be resumed with a free position.
4. When one player draws illegally, the free position may be taken by any player on the non-offending team at the spot of the ball.
5. When a goal circle foul is committed, the offending player – except the goalkeeper or deputy within the goal circle – shall move 4 meters away from the player taking the free position instead of behind.
