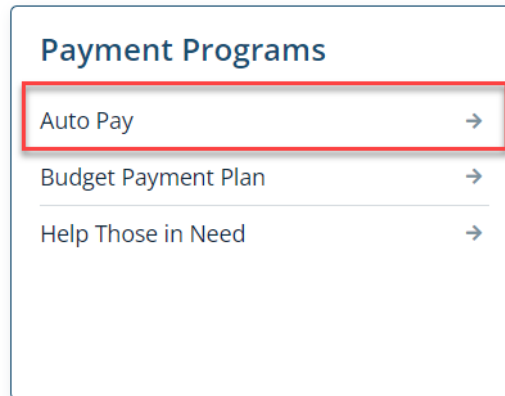


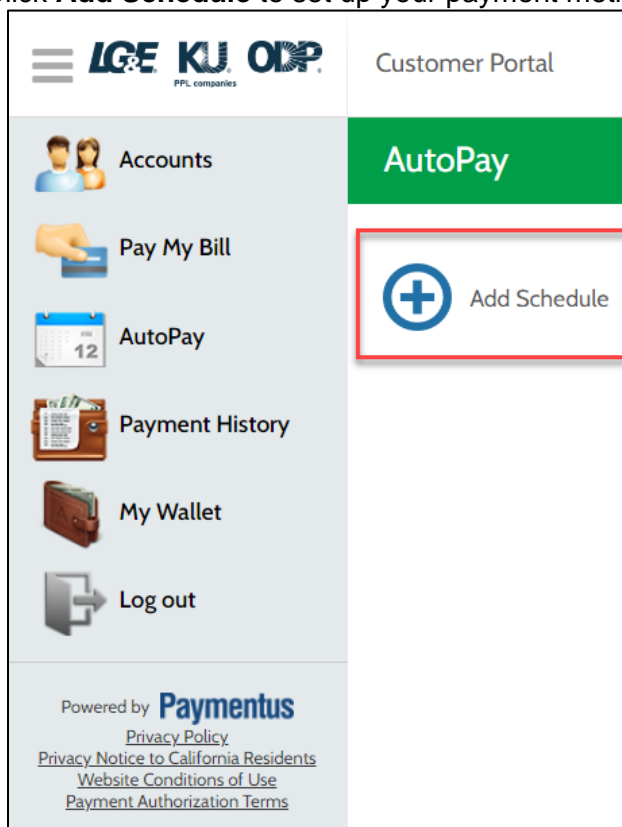
# How do I use My Account to sign up for Auto Pay using my debit or credit card?

- Visit [my.lge-ku.com](http://my.lge-ku.com) and sign in to your account.
- In the **Payment Programs** section, click **Auto Pay**.



- To use a payment method other than a checking or savings account, review program information and click **Sign up for Paymentus Auto Pay**.
- Debit/credit card payments are processed through our vendor Paymentus, and you will be taken to the Paymentus Portal. Click **Add Schedule** to set up your payment method.



## How do I use My Account to sign up for Auto Pay using my debit or credit card?

- Instructions are provided to help you enroll.
- If you have one or more accounts listed, click the account which you want to enroll in Auto Pay. If you want to add a new account not listed, click **Add new**. Otherwise, click **Continue**.
- Add a payment method. Choose from Credit, Debit or Digital Wallet (PayPal, PayPal Credit, Venmo, Amazon Pay, Google Pay or Apple Pay). After making your selection and entering your payment information, click the checkbox to agree to the Payment Authorization Terms and click the **Set as default payment method** checkbox. Then click **Add**.
